



Stanco Metal Products Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

Stanco Metal Products supports the objective of Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. The act aims to end the violence and human rights violations in the mining of certain minerals from a location described as the conflict region in the DRC and surrounding countries.

As a privately held company, Stanco Metal Products is not directly subject to the SEC rules. We are, however, committed to ensure that the listed conflict minerals are not used to manufacture our products and will assist our customers in complying with the reporting obligations required under Section 1502 of the Act. This includes conducting reasonable country of origin inquiries into the source of any conflict minerals used in our products and providing this information to our customers where applicable.

Stanco Metal Products is further committed to not knowingly purchase products or materials which contain conflict minerals from the aforementioned regions.

Stanco Metal Products similarly expects our suppliers to source product only from responsible sources, including the use of smelters that appear on the CFSI smelter list.
